Fall 2011 Preschool Storytime Information

Here in the Children's Room we are constantly striving to offer the best quality programs we can. Updates and changes are often necessary to serve you better. This posting is to let you know about the changes to the Preschool Storytimes that start in September.



We are going to be requiring registration for Preschool Storytime this Fall. Starting on August 20th, you can sign up for one of our fall sessions. Our Fall sessions will be for six weeks, followed by a two week break. Each session will have classes offered at different times so that everyone gets a chance to experience storytimes at the library.

Preschool Storytimes will still be broken up into age groups, so there will be separate storytimes for three year olds, four year olds, and five year olds (though siblings are welcome to stay together if there is room in the session). There will be space for 15 children in each age group's storytime.

By requiring registration, we get to know the children better. We can also plan better when we know how many children are attending on a regular basis, especially for holiday parties.

By offering this program in six week sessions, we can plan better crafts and activities for Preschool Storytimes. Storytimes themselves will also be around forty five minutes or longer. We also get to extend our outreach services to other daycares and schools in Hooksett.

We hope that you will like the new schedule set up and it will be convenient for everyone. We are currently planning on having three six week sessions in the spring of 2012.
