Painting—ML went to Queen City Paint to get referral names and has called and spoken with three painters who say they will come in this week to look at rooms and provide estimates. ML will follow up and keep trustees posted.

Masonry—ML has spoken with Richard St Cyr who came up to look at the steps that need to be repaired. Although he can't find the same edging, he dropped off a sample of a metal edge covered in slip proof material that he can bolt into place. Trustees voted and agreed to go ahead with his idea if and when his estimate looks good to us. ML left a message for him tonight that we need his estimate as soon as he is able to provide it so we may be able to move forward. ML also let him know that there are two spots on the steps where the current edging has come loose and also needs to be included in the estimate. Trustees voted to authorize if estimate is under \$1500.

Library Easement & Sign—MB discussed status of issues. MB asked HS for patron complaint feedback

Status of job descriptions and performance appraisals- HS reports that the reports are all written and she did meet with Mark today. Will complete all reviews which are scheduled this week when the employees are available. Summary of pay and benefits will be included and will update trustees by week's end

Computer Issues- network maintenance performed—HS reported that the public computers will be worked on this week.

Website—HS reported that now that she is back from vacation, Mark is working with Dreamweaver and will work through Friday after acquisitions are complete. BD offered Ben's assistance this week if necessary
